

**Application for entry into the electoral register**

In order to exercise the right to vote, you must be entered in the electoral register in a municipality on election day. Norwegian nationals who have lived abroad for more than 10 years must apply for entry into the electoral register where the voter was last registered as resident. You do not need to apply if you've been registered in the National Registry any time in the past 10 years before election day.

Application for entry is included on the envelope used for advance voting abroad, on Svalbard and Jan Mayen. The application can also be written as a letter. You can use the application form on this page if you desire. If you opt to write the application as a letter, you must ensure that you include all the required information from the application form.

The electoral committee in the municipality you were last registered as resident, must have received your application within the day after election day, 28<sup>th</sup> November 2023 at 17:00.
